### Art Gallery Exhibitions

The current exhibit in the Douglas County Law Library Art Gallery is a collection of paintings by Colleen Zacharias Gregoire. Ms. Gregoire has been a professional artist and instructor for the past twenty years. She earned her MFA in painting from the University of Kansas and has taught in the Art and Design Departments of KU and Baker University in Baldwin City, Kansas. She currently teaches independent drawing and painting workshops in the Lawrence area. Her award-winning art has been included in juried competitions across the country and can be found in numerous private and public collections.
